Engineers are honest, truthful and fair in presenting information and making public statements reflecting on professional matters and their professional role.  
Engineers engage in professional relationships without discrimination of race, religion, sex, age, national origin or handicap.  
Engineers act in professional matters for each client as a faithful agent or trustees, disclosing nothing of a proprietary nature concerning to the business affairs or technical processes of any present or former client or employer without specific consent.  
Engineers disclose affected parties known for potential conflicts of interest or other circumstances which might influence – or appear to influence- judgment or impair the fairness or quality of their performance.  
Engineers perceiving a consequence of their professional duties to adversely affect the present or future public health and safety shall formally advise their employers or clients and, if warrant, consider further disclosure.  
Engineers accept responsibility for their actions; seek and acknowledge criticism of their work; offer honest criticism of the work of others; properly credit the contributions of others and do not accept credit for what is not part of their work.  
Engineers are responsible for enhancing their professional competence throughout their careers and for encouraging similar actions by their colleges.

## Requirements

Ethical commitments, responsibility before Boards of Engineering of the United States. That should demonstrate by each member by his/her acceptance to any State Board of the United States to a registration or licensing process; an acceptance or probe of examination of any of the engineering registration exams could be considered acceptable, CAPE also encourages it's members to follow professionalism and educational programs including those pursuing bilingual requirements.

In issues such as protecting the integrity of engineering registration, liability reform, taxation, competitive bidding, etc., are to be influenced by engineers, we must continue to increase our level of commitment so that our impact within Colombian community will become more significant.
